



## ARKANSAS AGRICULTURAL CONSULTANTS ASSOCIATION COMMITTEES

### 1. **Program**

Committee works together to develop items to be on the annual program.

### 2. **Membership & Rules**

Suggest prospective consultants to become members. Review and recommend approval or disapproval of all new membership applications. Periodically examine the eligibility and classification of all members with special consideration given to Article III, Sections 2 and 3 of the Constitution (Requirements for Regular and Associate Membership). Make recommendations concerning cancellation or reclassification of memberships.

### 3. **Scholarship**

Review applications from students and select recipients of scholarships.

### 4. **Grievance**

Committee will review any complaints against members and investigate and report to membership. Act as a representative body of the AACA on any occasion where the executive body or membership at-large deems it necessary. Promote good will and cooperation between the Arkansas State Plant Board and the AACA.

### 5. **Audit**

Committee will review financial statement and recommend to membership to accept or question the report. Investigate any problems found with the statement.

### 6. **Nominating**

Committee will review membership and select a candidate to run for each elected office.

### 7. **Legislative**

Committee will review legislation that may impact AACA and inform membership and recommend what actions should be taken.

### 8. **Plant Board**

Work with ASPB and review actions and report to membership.

### 9. **Man of the Year**

Committee will review applications for Man of the Year and make recommendations to membership for a vote.

### 10. **Website**

Committee will provide input on the initial design of the AACA website, as well as provide input on updates as needed.
